A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

Palm Sunday

Dear friends in Christ,

This day was bittersweet for Jesus. On one hand, His heart was filled with joy as He was welcomed into Jerusalem by the crowds, who proclaimed Him as their Messiah. We can envision Jesus Christ as the King ("Ο Χριστός είναι Βασιλιάς!" in Greek) triumphant and glorious. Yet at the same time, it was a day full of sorrow, for He knew very well that He was heading for a glory that first had to go through the most bitter pain, the deepest misunderstanding, and the saddest abandonment. And thus, He showed us that, even in the face of the deepest pain, it is possible to stand firm. Our own lives mirror this duality, filled with so much pain and so much joy at the same time. The secret to remaining steadfast and joyful, despite the weight of our own crosses, is to remain close to the source of life - Christ Himself. Only at His feet can we face the challenges of every day, the small and the great. With Him beside us, we can still smile, even when the burden of the cross is the heaviest and the most bitter. Life is a continuous Palm Sunday, filled with both challenging and joy-filled days. Yet, as St. Paul reminds us, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13). This means that only by proclaiming Christ as the true and only Messiah of our lives are we prepared to endure pain and emerge victorious. God loves you with infinite tenderness. Happy Sunday!

Solamente a sus pies podemos hacer frente a los retos de cada día, los pequeños y los grandes. Solamente a con Él podemos sonreír, aunque la cruz sea la más pesada y la más amarga. La vida es un continuo Domingo de Ramos, a veces tenemos días malos y a veces días buenos, pero como dijo San Pablo: "Todo lo puedo en Cristo que me fortalece" (Filipenses 4:13) Eso significa que solamente cuando proclamamos a Cristo como el verdadero y único Mesías de nuestra vida estamos listo para atravesar el dolor y salir victoriosos.
