Although, it is impossible to measure how many families/people utilize the box or what volume of groceries go into the box, we do know that the box is often empty. 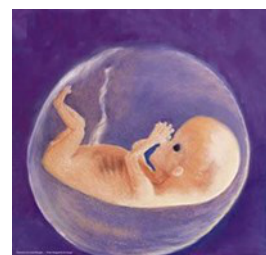

### MONTH 2 – DEVELOPING BABY – “I’M DANCING!” SPIRITUAL ADOPTION PROGRAM

Your baby is making progress developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. Baby-teeth buds are present at 6 ½ weeks. The central nervous system is functioning and 40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. From this moment, your spiritually adopted baby grows and refines her body. But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week. She is now called a “fetus” a Latin word meaning “little one”. Ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring, flip and jump – her first dance steps!

### OUR RCIA ELECT ARE BEING EXORCISED! (THE SCRUTINIES)

A scrutiny is one of the minor rites of the RCIA that involves self-searching and repentance. The purpose of the scrutinies is to strengthen the person to overcome temptations and to be strong in choosing what is upright and in following the Gospel. There are three scrutinies. After the readings and homily at the Liturgy the presider invites the catechumens and the assembly to silent prayer, intercessions for the Elect follows. The presider pronounces the exorcism. The exorcism is addressed to Christ, asking him to drive out the power of evil and replace it with the Holy Spirit. Scrutinies are celebrated on the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent. We ask for continued prayers for all of our elect.
