SPIRITUAL DROP

XVII Sunday in Ordinary time – July 26, 2026

We all have a treasure within us, but only a few discover it. The craving for more money, the craving for power, the unhealthy obsession with living a comfortable life free of any problems, running away from conflicts without trying to resolve them, the cult of the body, screen addiction, the intoxication of professional success, the gluttony of always wanting the perfect meal, and many other empty pursuits are increasingly burying the treasure with which God created us. A superficial life has us trapped, and the worst part is that we don't even realize it. We must return to the first Love—to the real and true God, the God who challenges us to be holy, to be different, to be signs of contradiction. God calls us to make serious and significant decisions so that we may be true witnesses of Him in the world. Often these decisions are very painful, but they always bear abundant fruit. Ask God this week: What do You want me to leave so that I can begin to be a deeper person, more Yours?
God loves you with infinite tenderness.
