Dear Parents,

Together with Fr. Osman, Fr. Raúl, Fr. Jorge, and the catechists, I want to welcome you to the 2026-2027 Religious Education program. Our goal is to encourage each child to make personal, knowledgeable, and heartfelt choices to become lifelong active members of the Catholic Church. We strive to create an educational program that promotes faith growth in families and participation in Church life which will be the foundation for their future.

We believe that parents are their children's first and most important teachers. Your own practice of faith is essential to your child's growth. You are giving a good example to your children, as well as growing in your own faith, by:

- ★ attending weekly Mass,
- ★ regularly receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation,
- ★ praying together daily,
- ★ speaking frequently about your faith at home,
- ★ attending special social activities at the parish, and
- ★ volunteering for service in our parish and community.

We understand that being a parent in today's society can have many challenges such as consumerism, technology, and the media. Our religious education program is based on scripture, prayer, tradition, service, and community. We are dedicated to supporting you in developing your child's understanding of the Catholic faith and providing opportunities to share your knowledge with them.

We ask that you **reinforce** the lessons presented in each class with follow-up conversations at home and **review** the material provided by the catechist. Your interest in their lessons is a great witness to the importance of their spiritual growth. As mentioned above, we ask that you attend weekly Mass and special Church activities with your child. We want them to know they are part of a vibrant St. Paul Chapel community!

Religious education classes are held **following 9:00 a.m. Mass and go until 11:15 a.m.**

- The priest will dismiss the students and catechists with a blessing just before the end of Mass.
- Students are asked to go directly to the classroom area where they will be provided with a snack before the start of their class.
- Tuition for religious education classes remains at \$35 for each child in the program. Please contact me if this causes a hardship for your family. I can be reached by email at: religiouseducation@stpaulcatholicchapel.org or by calling 260-665-2259.

Please remember that each catechist is a volunteer committed to generously sharing their passion for our faith with your child. We ask that you support your child's catechist and the religious education program.

Regular attendance is important. If your child must miss a class, please contact the catechist to obtain the missed content/materials. We trust that we will have your child's full participation and respect.

Please note, Sacramental preparation is an integral part of the religious education program. The Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist are prepared for in the second grade. The Sacrament of Confirmation is received after completing the Confirmation I and II classes. Parents whose children will be receiving a sacrament this year will need to attend special meetings as part of the preparations. We will have a parent meeting for **ALL parents** on the first day of classes, September 13th.
