

V SUNDAY OF EASTER

Dear Parishioners, Along with the joy of the Resurrection during this Easter season, the Lord has given us the joy of a new Pope. It was deeply consoling when, in his first address from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica, he greeted the world with the words, 'Peace be with you...' and then said, "Evil will not prevail." I believe Pope Leo XIV is bringing much hope into our Catholic Church. He is clearly aware of the turmoil that he has found in our Society and the Church, but at the same time, he knows that the power of love always conquers. In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." (John 13:34). We can demonstrate our love for our new Pope by committing ourselves to praying daily for him so that he can unite all things in Christ, who is the only One who can keep His people united and holy. I think that the Lord has given us a good shepherd according to His will to keep His Church united to Him, to the Pope, and to each other. It is providential that his election took place in May, the month of the Virgin Mary. Once again, we can see that she is working quietly but very hard behind the scenes, helping Jesus to bring new wine into the Catholic Church. Once again, she says to us as she said to St. Juan Diego on Mount Tepeyac, "Am I Not Here, I Who Am Your Mother?" God loves you with great tenderness. Happy Sunday!


Queridos feligreses,
