OUR RCIA ELECT ARE BEING EXORCISED! (THE SCRUTINIES)



Many of you attending the 10:00 am Mass may have wondered what is a scrutiny and why is the priest praying over them? A scrutiny is one of the minor rites of the RCIA that involves self-searching and repentance. The purpose of the scrutinies is to strengthen the person to overcome temptations and to be strong in choosing what is upright and in following the Gospel.

There are three scrutinies (celebrated on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent) and as some have seen, the presider invites the catechumens and the assembly to silent prayer and intercessions for the Elect follows. The presider pronounces the exorcism which is addressed to Christ, asking Him to drive out the power of evil and replace it with the Holy Spirit. We ask for continued prayers for all of our elect.
