XVI Sunday in Ordinary Time – July 19, 2026

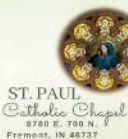
One of the major problems facing humanity today is the serious lack of concentration in everything we do. I've often wondered what future doctors, engineers, or any other future professionals—who are students today but don't like to read and are immersed in the empty world of social media or addicted to screens—will be like. It's frightening... we humans have a serious problem that we must humbly acknowledge: we are deeply distracted. This distraction

has profoundly affected our spiritual lives to the point that we no longer notice the details—and life, like the human body, is a collection of many small details. This distraction no longer allows us to hear the inner voice of our conscience, much less the gentle voice of God or the whisper of help from those beside us. We must awaken from this lazy lethargy and return to what we were created for: profound and heavenly things. Let us never forget that God is not superficial.
God loves you with infinite tenderness.
