Fifth Sunday of Lent

Dear friends in Christ,

As Lent draws to a close, it is time to make a deep examination of conscience, reflecting on whether we have fulfilled our Lenten resolutions we made at the beginning of this sacred season. First, we must examine whether we have faithfully followed what Jesus has asked of us, delving into the deepest part of our conscience, a place where only He and we can meet.

This is a perfect time to ask ourselves some challenging questions:

Have I devoted more time to prayer, deepening my relationship with God? How often have I fasted? How many works of charity have I offered to those in need? Have I accepted the crosses in my life with the love and patience Jesus exemplified? Have I come to recognize the suffering face of Jesus in the trials I face, seeing Him in the midst of my struggles? Do I feel that I have grown more in my love for God, becoming more attuned to His presence in my life? Have I made a sincere confession? Can I say that I have brought a smile to Jesus' face with my behavior this Lent? Fortunately, there is still time—time to continue seeking Jesus, asking Him what He truly desires from us. Perhaps He will remind us that He wants us to love ourselves, to give ourselves, to give ourselves entirely to Him and to others as He gave Himself entirely on the Cross that Good Friday.

MONTH 3—DEVELOPING BABY—"I CAN SUCK MY THUMB!"



Your baby is quite active in the womb now -- although his mother won't feel him for another couple of months. If his mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow and move his tongue. He can make a tight fist if you touch his palm. He is breathing amniotic fluid which continues until birth, although he obtains the oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce. Early this month -- at just 9 weeks -- he began to suck his thumb.

UPDATE ON RE-ROOFING OF THE FORMER CHURCH

The re-roofing of the former church has been met with a number of unfortunate delays. The various hurdles have all been negotiated and we finally have a contract in place with the contractor. These delays were unforeseen and have now pushed the re-roofing out for 8-10 weeks due to the contractor's inability to begin as result of these delays. We have been informed by the contractor, that if an opening in their schedule occurs, they will slip our project in with an anticipated time frame of two weeks to install the new roof. The sheet metal work, new gutters and downspouts would follow the re-roofing. While I know this delay will cause some unhappiness, we ask for your continued patience and understanding. Once completed, please know that we will have a water-tight building of which we will be proud once again. Your continued prayers and understanding will be appreciated.
