A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

Fourth Sunday of Lent

Dear friends in Christo,

A couple of weeks ago I went to the store to buy some things I needed for home, and I met a person who greeted me from afar but was very smiling and friendly. I didn't know who she was, I tried to remember who she was, but it was impossible, so I responded with the same joy as she greeted me. A week later I was hearing confessions in the confessional and that same person came to confession and said to me: "Dear Father, it was a great joy to see you that day in the supermarket, thank you for your smile and joy". And I said to myself: thank goodness I was kind. Phew, I was saved... The book of St. John tells us that he loved us first (1 John 4:19), that means that God was very kind to us, he took the first step in love to love us with a love with which no one has ever loved us before. The text of the Easter Proclamation that we will hear at the Easter Vigil says: What an amazing benefit of your love for us, what incomparable tenderness and charity! The word kind means: easy to love or worthy of love. I believe that Jesus is very easy to love because everything in Him is perfect, everything in Him is love. The challenge we have is to love others and accept them as they are, but at the same time try with all our strength to be like Jesus, to be kind, to love with tenderness and charity, even if others have defects, they are also children of God. Kindness is not only a gesture of courtesy, but it is a Christian lifestyle that consists in seeing in the other person the face of Jesus. I know this is very difficult but don't forget that God loved us first even when we didn't deserve it. Being kind could be a wonderful Lenten penance...or a lifelong one. God loves you with infinite tenderness.

La amabilidad no solo es un gesto de cortesía, sino que es un estilo de vida cristiana que consiste en ver en la otra persona el rostro de Jesús. 

APRIL IS CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH

It remains important for our Church to protect children and young persons from evils of abuse. The Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend remains committed to upholding and following its guidelines, policies and procedures that were implemented for the protection of children and young people. These can be reviewed on the diocese's website, www.diocesefwsb.org, under "Youth Protection." If you have reason to believe that a minor may be victim of child abuse or neglect, Indiana law requires that you report this to civil authorities. If you or someone you know was abused as a child or young person by an adult, you are encouraged to notify appropriate civil authorities of that abuse. In addition, if the alleged abuser is or was a priest or deacon of the Catholic Church, you are encouraged to contact Jodi Marlin, Victim Assistance Coordinator, at (260)399-1447 or jmarlin@diocesefwsb.org; or Rev. Mark Gurtner, Vicar General of the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend, at P.O. Box 390, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46801; at (260)399-1419; or at mgurtner@diocesefwsb.org. The diocese is committed to helping prevent the abuse or neglect of children and young people and to assist those who have suffered harm as a result of such abuse.
