A SPIRITUAL DROP FROM OUR PASTOR

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

As you may know, farewells are not easy.

For example, when someone we deeply love passes away, the pain can be immense. When a child leaves their parents' home to begin life on their own, the parents often experience a sense of loss. And when a best friend moves away to another city or country, holding back tears can feel impossible.

But are all farewells sad or bad?

We might imagine that the Apostles experienced a deep sadness when they saw Jesus ascending into heaven and had to say goodbye to their beloved Lord. Still, today's Gospel says that they returned to Jerusalem with great joy.

How is it possible to be joyful when your best friend has left?

They were joyful because they were sure of three important truths—truths we, too, should remember and hold in our hearts. First, they believed that Jesus was God, and therefore, He would fulfill His promise of coming back again and take them to be with Him.

Secondly, they firmly believed in all of His teachings, including the promise of eternal life. They knew that eternal life is real, and because of this, they understood that the Ascension was not the end.

And finally, they understood that this marked the beginning of their spiritual adulthood. Jesus was returning to His Father, and now it was their time to go out into the world and to do with joy what He had commanded them. Their sorrow was transformed into the great and joyful responsibility of the Christian mission.

The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord teaches us that farewells are not always sorrowful or negative. Sometimes, they bring with them deep hope and valuable lessons that enrich our lives.

God loves you with great tenderness.

Por ejemplo, cuando muere alguien a quien tanto amamos, sufrimos mucho; o cuando un hijo tiene que dejar la casa de sus padres para comenzar una vida por su cuenta los padres sufren mucho, o cuando tu mejor amigo debe irse a otra ciudad o país, contener nuestras lágrimas es simplemente imposible.

Pero, ¿todas las despedidas son tristes o malas? Podríamos pensar que los Apóstoles experimentaron una profunda tristeza cuando vieron a Jesús ascender al cielo y tuvieron que despedirse de su amado Señor, pero el Evangelio de hoy dice que regresaron a Jerusalén con gran alegría. ¿Cómo es posible estar alegre cuando tu mejor amigo se ha ido? Estaban alegres porque estaban seguros de tres cosas importantes que debemos recordar y guardar en nuestro corazón. Primero, creían que Jesús era Dios y por lo tanto Él cumpliría su promesa de regresar de nuevo para llevarlos con ellos. En segundo lugar, creían firmemente en todas sus enseñanzas, incluyendo que la vida eterna existe y es real y, en consecuencia, sabían que ese no era el final. Y finalmente, comprendieron que era el comienzo de su adultez espiritual porque Jesús regresaba a su Padre y ahora era su tiempo de ir al mundo y hacer con alegría lo que Él les había mandado. La tristeza es superada por la grande y gozosa responsabilidad de la Misión Cristiana. Esta solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor nos enseña que las despedidas no son necesariamente tristes o malas siempre, pero a veces traen muchas esperanzas y aprendizajes a nuestra vida.
