

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

As you may know, farewells are not easy.

For example, when someone we deeply love passes away, the pain can be immense. When a child leaves their parents' home to begin life on their own, the parents often experience a sense of loss. And when a best friend moves away to another city or country, holding back tears can feel impossible.

But are all farewells sad or bad?

We might imagine that the Apostles experienced a deep sadness when they saw Jesus ascending into heaven and had to say goodbye to their beloved Lord. Still, today's Gospel says that they returned to

How is it possible to be joyful when your best friend has left?

They were joyful because they were sure of three important truths—truths we, too, should remember and hold in our hearts. First, they believed that Jesus was God, and therefore, He would fulfill His promise of coming back again and take them to be with Him

Secondly, they firmly believed in all of His teachings, including the promise of eternal life. They knew that eternal life is real, and because of this, they understood that the Ascension was not the end. And finally, they understood that this marked the beginning of their spiritual adulthood. Jesus was returning to His Father, and now it was their time to go out into the world and to do with joy what He had commanded them. Their sorrow was transformed into the great and joyful responsibility of the Christian mission. mission.

The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord teaches us that farewells are not always sorrowful or negative. Sometimes, they bring with them deep hope and valuable lessons that enrich our lives.




